For the protection of users of our website, we have safeguards in place to identify and prevent unauthorized attempts to access or cause harm to information and systems. With data encryption up to 256-bits, nsProtect Secure SSL Certificates convert your data into virtually impenetrable code that is safe from hackers and identity thieves.

Our server automatically collects and saves information you chose to enter. Specifically, for each visit, the date and time, the originating IP address is logged. We periodically analyze these logs determine the traffic statistics and identify potential performance issues.

For site security purposes and to ensure that our services remain available to all users, we monitor network traffic to identify unauthorized attempts to upload or otherwise disrupt the website operation. Unauthorized attempts to upload information or change information on this server are strictly prohibited and subject to prosecution under the Computer Fraud and Abuse Act of 1986 and Title 18 U.S.C. Sec.1001 and 1030. This information will be used for authorized law enforcement investigations.

Email is not received by our website. We use email to confirm that the user has entered information with a summary of the services requested. None of the personal data is included in the email confirmation. The information you share with us is not used in anyway other than to accomplish the services requested. This may require sharing some personal information with a settlement broker to acquire rated-age information, trained medical personnel, CMS or as otherwise required by law. We do not use any shared information for profiling or dissemination to other private organizations.

Use of Persistent Cookies and Tracking Technology

We use memory resident cookies to maintain browser session integrity. When you exit our site, and your session is completed, the cookie terminates.
